A rough draft of your paper is due in class on Monday, January 5th.

General Guidelines and Formatting:

- Typed **and** printed out
- Double-spaced
- 12 point Times New Roman font
- MLA formatting for header and page numbers, etc.
- Must contain textual support/evidence (direct quotes)
- Direct quotes must be cited using formatting for MLA in-text citations

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## **Prompt:**

Hubris is defined as "exaggerated pride or self-confidence; arrogance."

Explain how hubris is at work in your supplemental reading choice in either causing the character's destruction or in bringing about the character's determination to survive or overcome adversity.

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Your essay should contain the following:

- Discussion/explanation of character traits and development
- A strong, clear thesis
- Specific details from text

Your essay should *avoid* the following:

- Summary of the plot
- Unnecessary/non-supportive details
- Lack of connection to prompt
- Repetitiveness
